Length of contract

The length of this contract is open and one month notice to quit will be given for either party.

Payment

The payment of £..... per week for each animal to be kept at livery will be reviewed annually and is to be made in **advance**. This can be made in cash or by standing order (ask for bank details). The date of payment will be of each month. Late payment will be charged at 10% of the total each month. Should payment be defaulted and the yard incurs recovery costs these will be passed on to the customer.

Identification

A detailed description of the animal and a photograph is to be supplied by its owner including its age, condition and details of any pre-existing injury, any allergies and the horse/pony's likes and dislikes. A list of any tack and equipment kept at the yard must be supplied to the owner of the yard.

Stables, Paddocks

Stables will be allocated to each horse and this will be its home for the period of its stay at the yard. A paddock will also be allocated for each owner on arrival at the yard but we may need to move the horses around, depending on the weather and if any work needs to be done to the paddocks. It is at the animal owner's discretion as to when the animal is turned out and brought in.

Insurance

The yard has adequate insurance and each horse/pony must have adequate cover. The horse owner must agree to waiver the yard's liability for personal injuries and injuries to the horse/pony. A copy of the insurance must be supplied to the yard. Mortality and Loss of use insurance cover yes/no (delete as appropriate)

Supervision

It is to be assumed that there is no supervision at the yard although the proprietors live on site and will often be available.

Included

This agreement is for..... Livery and includes the use of stable, paddock, supply of bedding and hay. The use of the ménage is included for the horses/ponies that are in residence.

Instruction

There is no formal provision for instruction in either horse maintenance or riding but if customers wish to teach others to ride the ménage is available for £10.00 per hour. External instructors are permitted for the tutorage of residence owners. External tutors, teaching non residents will be charged £10.00 per hour.

Veterinary care

The name address and telephone number of the vet is to be supplied to the proprietor along with emergency telephone number. By signing this agreement the horse/pony owner agrees to allow euthanasia on veterinary advice in an emergency if the owner cannot be reached. The veterinary practitioner will be allowed access to the yard for non emergency treatment

at any reasonable time of the day and at any time in an emergency. If the proprietor is available we must be told of any such visit in advance. It is the responsibility of the owner to ensure that their animals are wormed and inoculated regularly.

Farrier

It is the responsibility of the animal owner to ensure the shoes are maintained adequately: the farrier will have reasonable access to the yard. The date of appointments must be written on the calendar in the tack room.

Hours

The proprietors live on site and as such do not wish to be woken at unreasonable hours. We ask that you only visit between the hours **7.30am to 7.30pm**. Any visits outside these hours must be by prior arrangement with the proprietors.

Code of conduct (YARD CODE)

By signing this agreement the horse/pony owner agrees to abide by the code conduct as detailed on the next page. Failure of abiding to the code of practice will lead to immediate eviction from the yard with no refund.
